Track chair opportunities!

Tahquamenon Falls State Park's track chair program helps provide accessibility to the park's nature trails, wildlife and scenery.

Every season is track chair season!

Available to borrow on Saturdays in February and by reservation the rest of the winter.

Cost

Use of the track chair is free of charge, and is available on a first-come, first-reserved basis.

Track chairs were generously donated by Kali's Cure for Paralysis Foundation.

Reservations

The track chair may be reserved by contacting the park office during business hours (Monday – Friday from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.).

Park entry

The Track Chair is located at the Upper Falls Fact Shack.

A Recreation Passport is required on all vehicles entering the park. Recreation Passports may be purchased at the Michigan Secretary of State offices or at park entrances.

Ask park staff for a brochure with more detailed information.

Safety and rules

Service animals are welcome but must be under the control of their handler or a companion at all times. Visitors with pets must adhere to the state park rules regarding pets. Be advised that leashes, long clothing, blankets or other dangling items (i.e. camera straps, etc.) are at risk of becoming entangled in the chair. All track chair users must sign a waiver of liability.

Transfer options

If assistance is needed to transfer to the track chair, a companion must be able to assist with the transfer. Park staff and/or volunteers are unable to assist with transfers.



What to bring

You may want to bring water, bug spray, weather-appropriate clothing, a seat cushion, a hat, sunblock, sunglasses, snacks or a camera.
